## REPORT ON THE PENGUIN INTERNATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP REGATTA OF 1962

Sailed at Sayville Yacht Club, Blue Point, New York  
AUGUST 12, 13, 14, 15, 1962

Runyon Colie, Jr. of Philadelphia, (Downer Penguin Fleet), six time winner of the International Championship, did it again despite heavy competition from forty-seven entries representing thirty-one fleets. Bruce Goldsmith from Skokie Lagoons, Chicago (a former National Thistle Champion) who was consistently in the top five excepting the second race, placed second in the series. Otto Scherer, defending champion, showed them all how to sail "off the wind" and finished third in the standings. It was estimated that Goldsmith and Scherer picked up a total of 25 and 40 boats respectively "surfing" down wind in the four races having winds over ten miles per hour.

Runyon Colie won on excellent starts, clear wind and beautiful windward work. He had won three of the first four races, building a tremendous point lead, and needed to finish no better than eighteenth in the final race. He placed tenth in that race making it with the ease and confidence of a champion, although we understand he did admit to serious concern when the wind died completely, dropping him to twenty-fifth or so during one point of the final race.

Four former world's champions of the Penguin Class were present at the regatta; namely, Runyon Colie, Jr., J. Otto Scherer, Jr., Gardner Cox and Jim Carson.

Also a great deal should be said for the gals who crewed. The going was extremely heavy and rough through the second, third and fourth races, yet of the first seven skippers to finish in the final standings, six had wives aboard. Hats off to Betsy Colie, Pam Goldsmith, Kip Scherer, Marge Richards, Nancy Lockwood, Barbara Cox and Dot Harkrader.
